



Felipe Ríos Rodríguez

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Mr. Ríos is an Ocean Engineer from the Hydrometeorological Institute of Odessa, Ukraine. Mr. Ríos' professional experience dates back to 1990 when he made a sojourn at the Water Department of the Nicaraguan Institute of Territorial Studies. In 1999 he obtained his PhD degree in Oceanography from the University of Concepción, Chile. The subject of his PhD thesis was sediment transport in a port facing siltation problems. During his postgraduate studies, he made a 5-month sojourn at the Center for Coastal and Ocean Geological Studies of the Federal University of Rio Grande do Sul in Porto Alegre, Brazil. In 2002 he was hired as a lecturer/researcher by the Universidad del Mar in Oaxaca, Mexico. In that year, the Organization of American States Unit for Sustainable Development and Environment invited him to Costa Rica to participate as an external evaluator of project "Basic Studies in the San Juan River Basin and Coastal Zone". Mr. Ríos' work has been published in international peer-review journals. In addition to his career as an oceanographer, he has work for more than a decade as a freelance English-Spanish translator having provided translation services to BridgeLinguattec and other organizations. Presently, he is a Senior Oceanographer at BENTOS and is member of the Chilean Association of Marine Biologists.
